
Special Notices:

Take 76 to Somerset exit 110, Follow 219 S. to Salisbury (about 27 miles), Turn left at red light, Go 2 1/2 blocks, turn Rt. on Greenville Rd. Go 6.5 miles to Mountain Rd. on Left. Peniel Ln will be 1 mile on left.

Take 68 West to Rt. 546 North, (Finzel Exit 29), turn North on Finzel Rd. (546 N.) and go 3.5 miles, merge onto Greenville Rd continue another 4 miles. Turn right onto Mountain Rd. Peniel Ln. will be 1 mile on left.
