**LODGING** is available at the Roxbury campground: multi-family cabins, dorms for singles, hotel rooms (handicap accessible), as well as tent and RV sites.

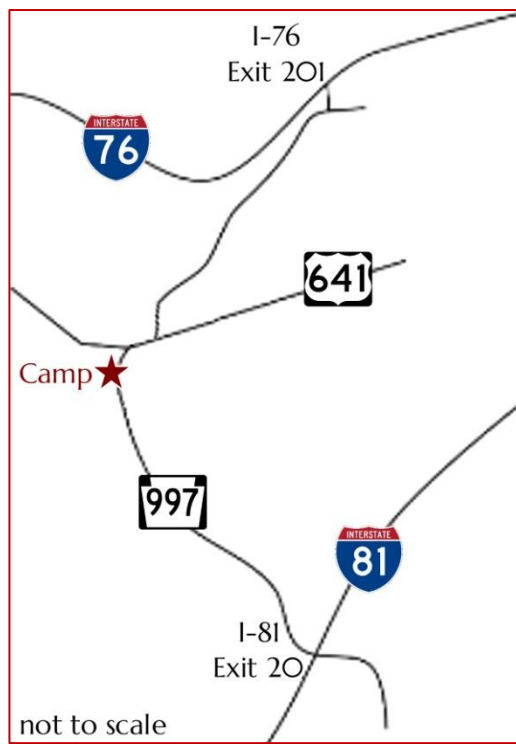
